PORT ROYAL GOLF & RACQUET CLUB

The Port Royal Golf & Racquet Club is a private membership club offering social activities and member privileges to the two, 18 hole golf courses, 14 tennis courts, croquet court, and clubhouse facilities which are operated by the Port Royal Golf & Racquet Club. Memberships include resident and non-resident "Sports Membership" (golf, tennis and social), "Golf Membership" (golf and social), "Tennis Membership" (tennis and social), and a "Social Membership". There is a one-time initiation fee. The amount depends on the type of membership desired. Information can be obtained by calling the Membership Office at 843-681-1700.

Each month members have exclusive "members only" play on one of the two courses. Members may also schedule and play either of the other public play courses. There are weekly men's and women's events, monthly mixed events, as well as special member-guest events, club tournaments, and interclub play events.

TURTLE TRACKERS

We are a volunteer organization in Port Royal whose mission is to promote sea turtle awareness on Hilton Head Island. One of the most important and impactful activities is to educate our residents and visitors about sea turtles and the sea turtle nesting season on the Island. Our volunteers work in conjunction with the Sea Turtle Patrol of HHI and support their mission of sea

turtle preservation. Landowners are invited to attend meetings at the Beach House scheduled for the third Monday of each month during nesting season and surrounding months.

WINE AND DINE

For more than 20 years, Port Royal residents have enjoyed good food and camaraderie in the Wine and Dine Club. Dinners are usually held on the 3rd Saturday of the month in October, November, January, and March.

Guests are divided into groups of eight. Each group meets in a home where the host prepares the entrée and the three other couples are assigned an appetizer, vegetable, or dessert to prepare. The committee makes all of the house assignments, prepare all the menus, and provides all the recipes. This is not a gourmet club so the recipes are user-friendly with ingredients available in our local markets.

Couples keep track of expenses for their part of the dinner. At the end of each meal, the expenses are totaled and divided by four. A typical dinner, including wine, will cost each couple between \$20 and \$25.

Everyone participating in Wine and Dine, including all of the substitutes, is invited to a holiday party at the Beach House in December. For this event, the committee prepares the entrée and dessert and guests bring side dishes. In the spring, everyone is again invited to the Beach House to become organized for the next year. Attendees bring heavy hors-d'oeuvres and regular participants sign up for the month in which they prefer to host for the upcoming year.
